1. Give any four possible design variations in ladies trousers?
2. State the special design features that could be incorporated in a single piece party wear for women
3. Differentiate between Men's shirt and Women's shirt.
4. Differentiate between Sherwani and Kurta based on the design features.
5. What are the points to be considered while designing children's playtime dresses?
6. Draw four designs for children's Night dress.
7. State some unusual figure problems for which pattern alteration is needed.
8. Write the causes for poor fit in a garment.
9. What is a dress form? How to prepare it for draping?
10. What are the types of muslins used for draping and state their applicability?

11. (a) Draft a pattern for ladies trouser with 1:4 scale. Using the following measurements Waist = 65 cm, Hip = 92 cm, knee = 34 cm, ankle = 23cm, body rise = 29 cm, waist to Hip = 20.6 cm.

Or

- (b) Design and draft pattern for a ladies shirt with 1:4 scale. Chest = 87 cm, waist = 68 cm, full length = 61 cm, Waist length = 36cm, shoulder from nape of neck = 16.5 cm, sleeve with shoulder = 68.5 cm.

12. (a) Design and draft a pattern for Nehru Kurtha.

Length-92 cm, Neck to Waist Length-42 cm, Chest-92 cm, Shoulder-43 cm, Neck-38 cm, Sleeve Length-62 cm, Sleeve Round-34 cm.

Or

- (b) Design and draft a Churidhar for Ladies. Full Length-100 cm, Hip-102 cm, Hem-28 cm, Knee-38 cm.

13. (a) Design and develop a pattern for children's uniform with the following measurement to 1:4 scale

Chest-60 cm, Bodice length-30 cm, Full length-68.5 cm, Shoulder-12.5 cm.

Or

- (b) Design and develop a pattern for Night dress for children with the following measurement to 1:4 scale

Seat : 72 cm, Full length : 85 cm, Waist : 66 cm, Bottom circumference : 40 cm, Chest : 56cm, Shoulder : 12.5 cm, Full length : 37cm, Sleeve with shoulder: 26 cm.

14. (a) Explain the pattern alterations to be done in a trouser pattern to rectify the fitting problems with neat diagrams.

Or

- (b) Explain the pattern alteration to be done in a Blouse pattern to rectify the fitting problems with neat diagrams.

15. (a) Explain the method of preparing patterns for a bodice pattern using draping method.

Or

- (b) Explain the method of preparing patterns for convertible collar, Peter Pan collar and Shawl collar using draping method.
