

## Synopsis

The project entitled 'Online Multilevel Marketing' is developed for Profluent Technologies, Coimbatore.

Till the advent of e-commerce, business transactions were done through postal orders. With the arrival of e-commerce and due to its effective online transactions, business has been placed on to a new track.

Multilevel Marketing is a setup, which carry out marketing at various levels in a Network Distribution Scheme. By which a company sells its products and constructs a chain of members, marketing people. The Network Distribution Scheme have five levels of marketing people, the sixth level above all is the company.

The system provides an online marketing environment for the company and its marketing people. It emphasizes on direct marketing over the web and deals with electronic market places. There will be no ink signed commercial documents thereafter.

The member has to register himself with the company by selecting any one of the two available schemes A and B, wherein he is given a user identity and password. The member has to select a product slab that he has to sell for the company. The administrator activates the member after he pays the registration fee. The member can invite and introduce new members to the NDS. The members can also place orders and records their sales details. The system maintains all the records of the members and accounts their transactions, which is sent as a monthly statement to them in the form of electronic mail. The company maintains several encouragement factors like bonus points, gifts and incentives for the members. The membership is valid for one year and at the end he is deactivated. The administrator, along with a renewal form sends a complete statement of all transactions in mail.

The system provides four major services i.e., Yellow pages, White Pages, Products and Alliances. The system also provides several other services and options for both the administrator and members, like changing passwords, viewing periodical reports on transactions, bonus strategies, status on the NDS, parent information, child information etc. Proper security features have been added in order to prevent unauthorized access during the transactions thus leading to a successful delivery of service.

# **1.INTRODUCTION**

## **1.1 PROJECT OVERVIEW**

Multilevel Marketing is the electronic transmission of business documents of the company online by means of the service providers. Electronic commerce is the process of using digital technology as the medium for transmitting information between business heads. The digital technology replaces the paper-based processes, resulting in lower costs, greater accuracy and higher speed. The advent of the Internet has fueled the explosive growth in this form of commerce.

Any person who is interested in multilevel marketing has to first register himself as a user. In the process of registration the members are given with two options scheme A and scheme B. Under Scheme A the member can select his parent and in the other the company allocates a parent to the member. The member also selects a product slab to sell for the company. The member is given a user identity and password.

By paying the registration fee through demand draft or cash the member is activated. The administrator allocates the member in the Network distribution Scheme. The immediate parents of the member are given commission. The activated member can invite and introduce new members by which he can get commissions and gets level increments Upto 5 levels in the NDS. The member sells the products to the customers and can enter the sales details. The member can also order new products for selling. The administrator intimates the members periodically with their monthly account statements through electronic mail. The member also gets the 4 warning notices from the administration on their membership expiry. Once the membership is over, the member is sent with a renewal form, cumulated accounts bonus points and accounts information. The member can enjoy the bonus points in the form of gifts or cash, which is left to him.

The system then works as follows,

- Registers the members and provides unique user identity and password.
- Activates the members after he makes the payment within 5 days from the day of registration.
- Sends a confirmation mail to the members on their registration and activations.
- Maintains the NDS by incrementing the members from one level to other based on the predetermined criteria.
- Maintains and sends periodical reports on the members account status (once in a month).
- Accepts orders from the members and records their sales details.
- Calculates bonus points and amount earned by each member every month.
- Monitors the membership period and provides warning mails to the members on their membership expiration in four stages.
- Finally deactivates and provides renewal forms to the members along with their cumulated accounts statements of one year.
- The system provides 4 major services,
  - White pages – information about the members,
  - Yellow pages – advertisements of the member's business,
  - Products – place for reselling of household and several such products
  - Alliances – place to find life partners and friends
- The system also provides options to change password and enter in formations to the services.
- For the administrator it provides all the rights to accept registration, activation of members, sending intimation to the members through mail, maintains the product slabs, maintains the services, management decision making, monitor the business status with the help of several management reports.

The whole system has been categorized into two – the client side and the

and sales details entry is all taken care of at the client side. Provisions have been given for the user on the client side to have proper security over the data that is being transacted. The system provides a very easy point-and-click user interface that helps in easy understandability and readability of the whole process. The user is given a confirmation fro the transactions made at each stage. The member can view the account details and NDS status at any stage. The standard and menu options of the screen makes the task of the member very simple since he can move to any page he likes, irrespective of whatever page he is in.

The server side functions from the viewpoint of the server side administrator of the company. He has the complete control over the databases in transit. The maintenance and Updatons of all the databases that has been used and the maintenance of the login information is done here. Provisions have been given for viewing the in formations in any of the databases by means of the corresponding reports. Security features have been added for proper authentication and for ensuring adequate security for the information contained within the databases. The amount, bonus points, level increments earned by the members are intimated to them and also entered into the databases by the server administrator. The list of products sold by the company is entered into the catalogue at this side as the system. The maintenance of the agreement, terms and conditions also comes under the task of the administrator, server side user.

The system is developed using

An advanced tool to communicate with the database and server by writing scripts.
- HTML (HYPERTEXT MARKUP LANGUAGE)  
Tool to provide good interface for use in web pages.
- JAVA SCRIPT  
Scripting language used to process client side requests faster.
- MICROSOFT SQL SERVER  
Back end database to store data.

## **2.SYTEM STUDY AND ANALYSIS**

### **2.1 EXIXTING SYSTEM**

Requirement analysis is used to analyze the knowledge about the existing system. After understanding the limitations of the existing system and the identification of the problems, alternative system solutions are studied and recommendations are made about committing the resource required to design the system. Various studies are done in order to get the information like,

- How the data are processed within the organization.
- How data is spread over the organization.
- How data are searched for within the organization.
- How the user communicate.
- How the user distribute the data to others for their user.
- What are the files currently in use within the existing system.
- How the data flows between these files.
- What are the procedures in use for the data retrieval and transit.

#### **Limitations of Existing System**

The existing system uses a manual system for most of the processes involved. Any user who wishes to have membership with the company does the registration process and signup the agreement all by means of the postal service. The company then sends a catalogue of product list whereby the customer. The whole system works in this manner until final deactivation of the member.

Since manual processing is the only way for accessing the information, this system leads to the following limitations.

- It increases the amount of paper work and clerical cost involved, thus by decreasing the productivity and increasing the costs.
- It results in wastage of time for the communication between the company and the members.

- There can be information mishandling at every stage during the transaction of the orders.
- It results in the unsecured information flow between the members and it can also lead to consistency and redundancy of the same information.
- With effect of all these limitations, the company loses its position in the market with respect to its competitors.

These disadvantages of the existing system have led to the development of the system using the digital technology, which replaces the paper work, resulting in lower costs, greater accuracy and higher speed.

## **2.2 PROPOSED SYSTEM**

The proposed system should be developed in such way to solve the problems faced by the existing system. For achieving this ideal environment is the windows, as it is the most popular multitasking system available today. The tool used to develop the system is Active Server Pages for its flexibility and versatility.

The proposed system is divided into two tracks, the member and the administrator. The system is given with the unique login identities so that any registered users and the administrators could login at anytime to verify their status. The member after registration he could be able to avail various facilities in the system.

The options should be given to the users are

- Mailing to friends and other new members
- NDS status verification
- Monthly / amount earned at any period should be viewed.
- Changing passwords
- Communicating with the administrator through mail
- Placing orders online and getting it. Entering and maintaining their sales status.
- Making entries in various services like yellow pages, alliances and products.
- Viewing various reports at his ease.

The options should be given to the administrator are

- The administrator first can give activate the registered members by making an entry in the NDS. Screens are provided for the administrator to enter the money details paid to the user and paid by the user.
- The administrator is provided with the master maintenance screens for all the services like yellow pages, white pages, products and alliances.
- The administrator is provided with a menu of options that helps him to monitor the current status of the company i.e., number of registrations made, number activated, number or deactivations, number of renewals and number of account statements sent.
- A special mailing facility should be given to the administrator to communicate with the members.

The process flow of the proposed system is, once the user or the administrator logs in proper validations is done. Then the user is allowed utilize various facilities available with a menu of options. As an administrator he can monitor and make management decisions with the reports that can be produced. As a new user he has to register himself by specifying his personal in formations and selecting his product slab. Then after he makes the payment of Rs 4000 he gets activated in the NDS and mail will sent to him to intimate his activation. Initially he will in level 1, then he can move up to 5 such levels,

Level 1 – new members

Level 2 – parent of level 1

Level 3 – parent of level 2

Level 4 – parent of level 3

Level 5- parent of level 4

Level 6 – mulimarket.com

Bonus points calculations, money earned by the members, money paid to the members regarding all these in formations mails are sent automatically every fourth week of a month. Similarly final warnings on deactivations, deactivations and renewal are done at the end of membership. At the end of membership the

The process of registering, getting monthly payment status, inviting and introducing new members, placing orders and recording the sales details are done via some electronic means. - The system should enable communication between the members and the company faster and more accurately. Since all the processes starting from the signup of the registration form, inviting and introducing new members,

Viewing monthly transactions etc all done electronically, it improves the efficiency and results in a more reliable way.

- It should increase the marketing power of the company there by increasing the nodes in their Network Distribution Structure

The system is partitioned into two – Client side and the server side depending on the mode of operation of the system by the corresponding user at each side. Hence the characteristics to be possessed by the user vary on both the sides.

- The user should know about the Multilevel Marketing strategies and the order in which the transactions take place in it.

The server side user (administrator) using the system should possess the following knowledge

- A fair knowledge about the Internet and the service providers is needed for operating the system. He should know about the use of mailing services and how to send mails.
- The administrator should have knowledge about maintaining databases and should know to give privileges to the members.

### **Reasons for selecting Active Server Pages**

The ASP is a technology for building dynamic and interactive web applications. The primary difference between ASP and the other new generation technologies mentioned is that Asp must be executed on the web server, while the pages generated by the browser or client). And the advantages that ASP, which makes us to choose our project, is that,

- **Simplicity and speed:** It is very simple and speed over the CGI and Pearl.
- **Browser Independence:** The ASP portion of a page runs on the server and sends only results to the client independent of the browser that is used by the clients.

- **Active Server Objects:** There are six Active Server Objects, each of which deals with specific aspect of interactivity and are intended and are intended to simplify browser and page control

- 1. Response Object**

Used to send information to the client.

- 2. Request Object**

Used to retrieve information included with the request from the client.

- 3. Server Object**

Used to communicate with the server.

- 4. Application Object**

Used to store (cache) information about your application.

- 5. Session Object**

Used to cache information about a specific browser instance (which usually, but not always, corresponds to a single user)

- 6.ObjectContext Object**

Used to initiate and control transaction and create new objects through Microsoft Transaction Server (MTS).

- 7. ASPError Object**

Used to obtain information about errors that occur while the ASP engine processes a script.

- **Quicker Loading Time:** ASP speeds-up the lading time because only the page of HTML is downloaded in the client's system.

- **Language Support:** Allows you to run programs in languages that aren't supported by the user's browser.
- **Data security:** ASP is able to provide the client with data that does not reside on the client's machine.

## Reasons for selecting Hyper Text Markup Language

Hyper Text Markup Language (HTML) is a collection of platform independent styles (indicated by markup tags) that define the various components of a World Wide Web (WWW) document. Tim Berners Lee while at CERN, the European Laboratory for Particle Physics in Geneva, HTML documents are plain-text files that can be created using any text editor.

An element is a fundamental component of the structure of a text document. Some examples are *head*, *table*, *form*, *paragraph* and *list*. To denote the various elements in a HTML document you should use tags. Some elements may include an attribute, which is additional information that is included inside the start tag. HTML is not case sensitive. The World Wide Web browsers support not all tags. If a browser does not support a tag, it will simply ignore it.

For processing the value from client side to server side we use HTML forms tag. The form can contain interface elements such as text fields, buttons, check box, radio buttons, and selection lists that let users enter text and make choices. Each interface element in the form must be defined with an appropriate tag. As well as user input elements, the form can contain other elements such as heading, paragraphs, tables and so on.

When the form is displayed in a web browser, the user can fill it out by making choices and entering text using interface elements, and then submit the form by clicking a "submit" button.

Forms uses two types of methods one is “post” and another is “get”. We pass the value into ASP file using ACTION method. The input values are taken in to the asp file for processing at the client side. Some times JavaScript is also used in the HTML file for more efficiency.

The above example pass the value of name and password for the verify.asp file and the user inputs are processed at the server side using ASP.

### **Reasons for selecting JavaScript**

JavaScript is an easy to use Object-Based scripting language designed for creating live online applications that link together objects and resources on both client and server. JavaScript is designed for use by HTML page authors and enterprise application developers to dynamically script the behavior of objects running on either a client or server. Netscape develops JavaScript and Microsoft develops Jscript. With JavaScript we can easily create interactive web pages.

JavaScript is

- Designed to create net-centric application
- Complementary to and integrate with java
- Complementary to and integrate with HTML
- Open and cross platform

### **Reasons for selecting INTERNET INFORMATION SERVER (IIS)**

The Microsoft IIS software is included with the Windows NT 4.0. We are

publish the web applications into Intranet. IIS combines Web, FTP and Gopher services and are managed by a single application, the Internet Service Manager.

The Microsoft Internet Information Server (IIS) is a secure, high-speed information publishing system that runs on Windows NT server. IIS is highly extensible through the use of Asp.

## **Features of Internet Information Server (IIS)**

### **HTTP 1.1 SUPPORT**

Hypertext markup Language (HTTP) 1.1 is an updated www protocol featuring improved transfer speed, tighter logon security, and adds virtual hosting abilities

### **HOST HEADERS**

Host headers allow multiple host names to be associated with a single IP address. This features means that IP address is not required for every virtual server. The only disadvantage to this method is that not all browser provide header support.

The most popular browsers including Netscape Navigator 2.0 and later and Microsoft Internet Explore 4.0 and later all support this protocol enhancement, making it an increasingly attractive solution for Internet service providers.

### **JAVA SCRIPT**

IIS fully supports Java and JavaScript on the client and server side. Microsoft Jscript is an open implementation of Netscape JavaScript. Jscript is a high performance scripting language designed to create active online content for the World Wide Web (WWW). Jscript allows developers to link and automate a wide variety of objects in web pages, including Active X controls and ASP programs.

## **Secure Socket Layers support**

Secure sockets layers are a security protocol that operates in between TCP/IP connections and HTTP service. Although not yet an industry standard, it can be implemented between Microsoft Internet explore Web clients and IIS. It provides the following features.

- Data encryption to protect transmissions.
- Server authentications to provide secure logons.
- Message integrity to ensure that messages have not been tampered.

A handshake procedure occurs between the client and server at the start of a session in which client and server agree on the level of security they will use to authenticate the connection. After authentication a normal HTTP connection session takes place, except that all data streams between the client and server are encrypted, including the following.

The URL requested by the client.

- Information entered on forms by the user, such credit card numbers.
- Access information like usernames and passwords.

## **5. SYSTEM IMPLEMENTATION AND TESTING**

### **5.1 SYSTEM IMPLEMENTATION**

As a policy every product in the company ready for release undergoes a configuration and release management process. Configuration in this system is categorized into two, the software configuration and the hardware configuration.

#### **Implementation Procedures**

The implementation procedure starts with the configuration management. The configuration is done according to the stepwise specifications given in the user manual.

The software configuration includes initially preparing the soft wares on which the system is going to run and comes the system configuration. The basic configurations that has to be done are,

#### **Registration and Renewal Module:**

- Initially the administrator will be given with an identity and password that has to be set according to the administrator's option.
- The Schemes are configured according to the companies' norms.
- The membership period are decided that can be a year or number of months
- The registration fee and other money factor i.e. the amount the members will be paid monthly and as bonus.
- The Gift master entries are given and the gifts are configured for the bonus points, along with the same in terms of money.
- The renewal period, the number and the frequencies of intimation on deactivations are configured.
- The period of time the registered member can take for making payment are

## Order processing and Accounts Module:

- The MLM product master entries should be given, i.e. the products that the company wants to sell are entered into the databases.
- The periods that the member can avail to make the payment on orders and receive the goods are determined.
- The number and the frequency of intimations on the account status of the members are configured.
- The bonus points that have to be given for the members on their sales target are decided.

## Services

- The authentication over the services, access by the members and the non-members are configured.

These are the major software system configurations that have to be done primarily. Covering all the key points above an installation program and a user manual are given to the user. Along with the above all things training for the user are given, which also fall under the implementation procedure.

## User Training

The kit delivered consists of a complete guide on the new system developed. A through training on the new system is given to a representative from each of the user area and an overall demo given to the entire team. The queries from the audience were answered and hints given on various issues. Special training was given to the admin staff that is to play the role of super user. The configuration details and trouble shooting methodologies were explained and his performance absorbed. The user manual was completely explained and doubts cleared for the same. Installing and uninstalling the package and taking a backup of the data were demonstrated to the super user. Various possible exceptions and the possible causes for it from the user's end were explained. The various user environments

successful operation of the system and trouble shooting methodologies were thus discussed.

## **Operational Documentation**

Properly produced and maintained system documentation is a tremendous aid to maintenance engineers. The system documentation includes all of the documents describing the implementation of the system from the requirements specification to the final acceptance test plan.

A complete set of Operational Documentation was prepared for the client, which included the features of the system, the access rights allocated for various users and trouble shooting details. The special features of the system were highlighted. A step-by-step procedure was included in the documentation for data entry, report generation and saving reports in text, html or rich text format. The documentation is prepared keeping in mind users who have little or no knowledge of computers.

The operational documentation includes a document describing the overall architecture, a maintenance guide, a user manual for operations like data entry, report generations, trouble shooting and a list of error codes and their causes and solutions. The purpose of input controls and the validations for the same are explained diagrammatically. A clear picture of the system and its functionalities are thus provided.

## 5.2 System Testing

### Testing Process

Testing is an action of finding facts and defining it. Except for small systems, system testing must be carried out in stages that are unit testing, module testing, system testing and acceptance testing. But for the small systems, system testing can be single, monolithic or unit. The testing of this system is done then and there in parallel with the development of each module. Each and every module immediately after it has been finished is subjected to testing. The major and chief testing carried out is,

### Black Box Testing

This test relies on the specification of the system or component, which being tested to derive test cases. Considering the system as a black box its behavior is determined by studying its inputs and the related outputs.

In this system testing is carried as, a new member registration is done along with the front-end validations for all the screens. Following the test on registration the administrator activates him in which the activated member is checked for his position in the NDS, which must satisfy the predetermined position for him

Then following the activation the member is subjected to all the transactions i.e. order processing, sales entry etc, of the system, which covers both the upper and the lower boundaries of the system. The user is then activated and the status of the NDS is maintained.

### Structural Testing

This is the complementary approach to the black box testing. In this testing a

In this system for example registration can be done in two scheme one is A and other B. When the user selects A he can select the parent while with the other scheme B he cannot select his parent. So based on this test cases are prepared that the user registration in B should not be allowed to select his parent and vice versa. Thus similarly each module is prepared with such test cases that could be finally accumulated to form a testing manual and are used for efficient testing of the system

### **Path Testing**

This is a common and basic testing that is done along with the development. The idea behind the testing is traveling all the logical paths of the system. That is registering in both the schemes, posting orders, entering the sales information, making payments by cash and by DD. Utilizing all the services i.e., addition, deletion, modification and search. And other administrative activities, along with sending mails and printing reports.

## 6. CONCLUSION

The system provides provision for both New user and Registered user. Every user who wishes to be a member of multimarket.com is provided with the Login name and Password. Proper securities features have been given within the system in order prevent unauthorized access. Every action performed by the user on the client side is acknowledged by confirmation. The whole system has been designed in an easily understandable point and click interface way. The user has been provided with the provision to view the system details. Changing the password option is given order to give more security to the users.

The system is designed in such an extendable fashion to incorporate the future changes into the system easily. The various user-friendly features are introduced in this project. There are several future ideas to develop this web application, still in mind. The system is developed according to the requirement produced by the organization. All the dynamic links to other pages are tested with the actual system. And the application can be run in any browser, but is mainly designed for the Internet explorer.






