1 Talent Management Challenges in India's Agriculture Sector

The leadership is aware of these challenges and has initiated measures like offering competitive salaries, rural allowances, and leadership development programs. However, the results have been mixed, and the company continues to struggle with high turnover and low engagement levels.

AgriGrow's management is now seeking innovative strategies to improve its talent management framework while addressing the unique challenges of the agriculture sector in India.
